

Priority Placement Program for Spouses

The Military Spouse Preference Program applies to spouses of active duty military members of the U.S. Armed Forces, including the U.S. Coast Guard and full-time National Guard, who desire priority consideration for competitive service positions at DoD activities in the U.S. and its territories and possessions.

.....How to Register.....

Required documentation for enrolling in the Priority Placement Program (PPP) for Spouses.

- 1) PCS ORDERS. The orders MUST include the reporting area of Fort Stewart/Hunter Army Airfield/ COE Savannah area. Must state dependent travel YES or have information authorizing you to accompany the Service Member to the New Duty Station (and must have been issued less than two years ago).
- 2) Must have a **MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE** for proof the marriage to the service member occurred prior to the ISSUE of the orders.
- 3) Must have a **CURRENT RESUME** built in USAJOBS.GOV
- 4) PPP(S) Packets should be provided to CPAC, 55 Pony Soldier Road, Bldg 253, Fort Stewart.

In order to be eligible for placement, you must be well qualified to perform at least one specific type of position.
