PLEASE READ BEFORE PROCEEDING TO THE APPLICATION PROCESS

Please remember you must complete all of the steps of the application procedure before you can start volunteering but you do not have to complete all of the steps at once. Please don't hesitate to give us a call with any questions, 912-767-2197.

We conduct mandatory Red Cross volunteer orientation for all volunteers each Tuesday in our office at noon. You can register for the orientation during the application process. Please register for the orientation before attending. We may not be able to accommodate you if you haven't registered ahead of time. As part of the application process, you will have to complete a mandatory background check. **You will complete this portion in our office at orientation.** Please wait to complete this in our offices. Any incorrect submissions may cause a delay in your background check and application.

● **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR WINN HOSPITAL VOLUNTEERS**

1. If you would like to volunteer at the Hospital, there is an additional mandatory hospital orientation held on the first Thursday of every month at 9:30 in the Patriot Theater. You may register for the hospital orientation during the application process.

2. Complete [HIPPA Training](#) and [H.E.A.R.T.](#) training. You can do that in our office after orientation, at the Education Center outside of Gate 1, or at WINN if you are not able to connect to the site at home. Print your completion certificate and bring it with you to the hospital Orientation.

- 3. Obtain a medical certificate by making an appointment at Occupational Health 912-435-5101 Bldg. 308. Bring your shot records to the appointment and once completed, bring certificate to the Hospital Orientation.
- Some positions require additional training and/or certification. You may speak to Brigitte Shanken, Hospital Volunteer Coordinator, at the orientation about your assignment or if you have any questions.
