Play a role in helping to end Housing Discrimination

What can you do to help?

You can help end housing discrimination by becoming a tester. As a trained tester, you will be called on to help identify possible instances of discrimination in housing. Under state and federal law, it is illegal for a housing agent or provider to discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, disability, national origin or familial status (presence of children under 18 in a household). The best method for detecting discrimination is through "testing."

What is a Tester?

A tester is a "shopper", an a person that plays the role of a bona fide home seeker (renter, home buyer, etc.) —a person who is looking for a place to live for the purpose of gathering information.

What is testing?

Testing is a way of measuring differences in the quality, quantity and content of information and service given to housing consumers (renters, home buyer, etc.) by housing providers as part of their normal business practices. Some unlawful housing discrimination practices can only be discovered through fair housing testing. Information gathered can be used as evidence to support a complaint filed with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development against a housing provider .

How do I qualify to be a Tester?

Testers will receive training to prepare them to be "objective fact finders." You will learn to be careful observers, accurate reporters and truthful witnesses. You will receive a payment for each completed test and completed paperwork.
